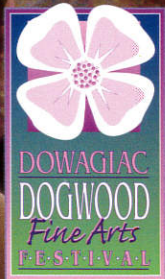
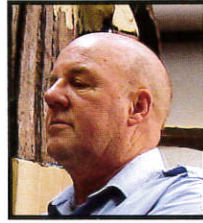

tuck langland

Tuck Langland created the signature sculpture *On With Life* for Dowagiac's Borgess-Lee Memorial Hospital.

Langland has created numerous signature sculptures including those for other hospitals across the country. Nationally he did *My Brother and I*, a portrait sculpture of the Mayo Brothers for the Mayo Clinic in Rochester, Minnesota, *New Life* for the Woman's Hospital of Texas in Houston, and *Circle of Care* at the Hillman Cancer Center at the University of Pittsburgh in Pennsylvania.

Langland, who lives in Granger, Indiana, is a local sculptor with a national reputation. He was elected to Fellow in the National Sculpture Society and Academician in the National Academy of Art. His sculptures are in the Meijer Gardens, Grand Rapids, Michigan, Schedel Gardens outside Toledo, Ohio and Brookgreen Gardens near Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. His works are also in the permanent collection of the British Museum in London and the Smithsonian Air and Space Museum among others.

Langland is Professor Emeritus at Indiana University South Bend, a Kenan Master Sculptor, and winner of many awards for sculpture and for teaching. His books, "From Clay to Bronze" and "Practical Sculpture" take his teachings around the world.
