Home Incentive Program

Code Officer, Steve Allen, reported on the results of the latest Home Incentive meeting held on 8/26/2015.

There was a balance of \$1,900.00 left in the housing fund and \$1,525.00 left in the tree removal fund.

Nine applications were reviewed for housing rebates with projects totaling \$38,620.00.

A total of \$2,225.00 was awarded to home owners. A transfer of \$325.00 was made from the tree fund to cover the total award amount. There is now a \$0.00 balance in the housing fund.

One application was reviewed for tree removal with a project cost of \$1,100.00. A total of \$200.00 was awarded for tree removal. There is \$1,000.00 left in the tree removal fund.


Prescription Turn-in
