

# CASS COUNTY WATER SYSTEM

## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT PAGE

### **General.**

A potable water supply system is designed and installed to prevent contamination from nonpotable liquids, solids or gases being introduced into the potable water supply. Connections shall not be made to a potable water supply in a manner that could contaminate the water supply or provide a cross-connection between the supply and a source of contamination unless an *approved* backflow prevention device is provided. **Cross-connections between an individual water supply and a potable public water supply shall be prohibited. Approved backflow prevention devices shall be installed and tested by a licensed Plumbing Contractor.**

### **Water service pipe.**

The outside pipe from the water main or other source of potable water supply to the water-distribution system inside the building, terminating at the service valve.

### **Pipes through footings or foundation walls.**

Any pipe that passes under a footing or through a foundation wall shall have built into the foundation wall or floor a pipe sleeve two pipe sizes greater than the pipe passing through.

### **Inspection.**

Permit covers inspection of water service pipe installation. If structure is accessible at the time of this inspection the final inside connections will be inspected at this time. If access is not possible an additional inspection and associated fees will be required.

### **Permit Holder terms of acceptance.**

It is assumed that the proposed work is authorized by the property owner, and that the permit holder is authorized by the owner to secure this permit. The permit holder agrees to conform to all applicable laws of the State of Michigan, the local jurisdictions as well as take responsibility for and comply with all connection requirements and inspection procedures. All Authority and Township employees and inspectors will be held harmless of any and all damages, civil actions and lawsuits related to any work performed resulting from the issuance of this permit.
